




#### New Jersey vs. United States, Labor Force Participation Rate: July 2018 - July 2019











#### New Jersey Counties Unemployment Rates - June 2019

(Preliminary, Not Seasonally Adjusted)




#### New Jersey Counties Unemployed Residents - June 2019

(Preliminary, Not Seasonally Adjusted)




#### New Jersey Counties Labor Force Per Square Mile - June 2019
