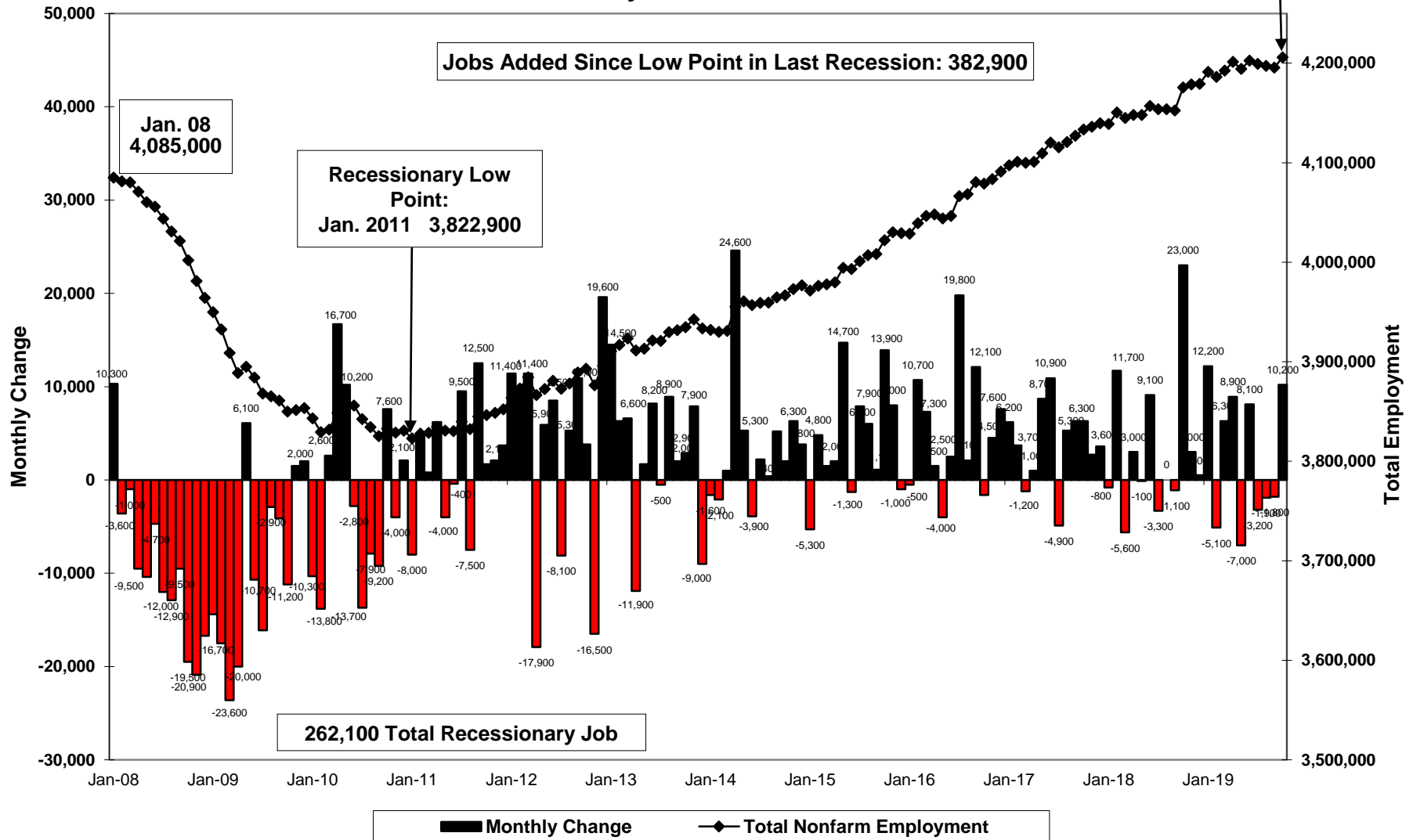

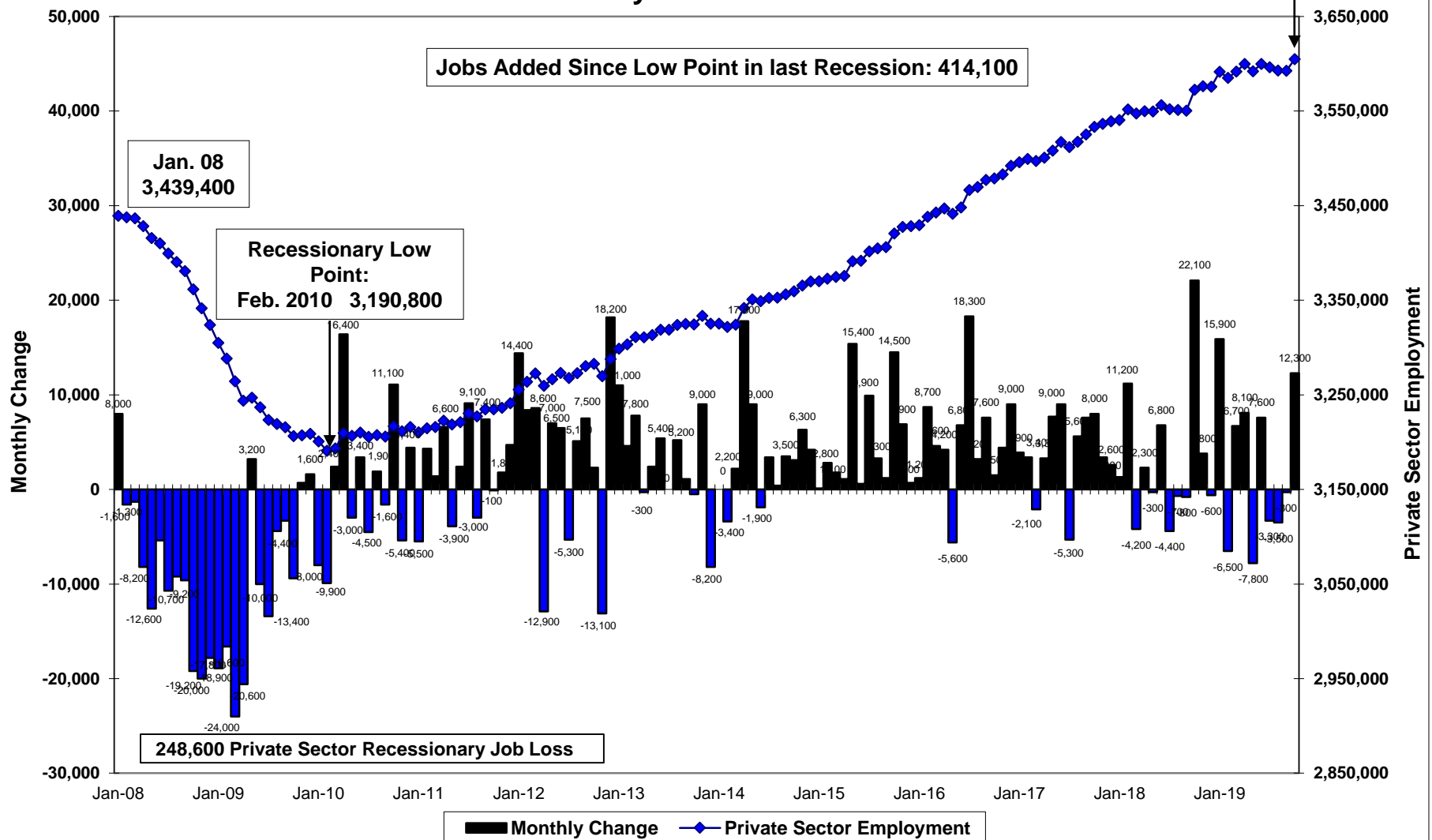

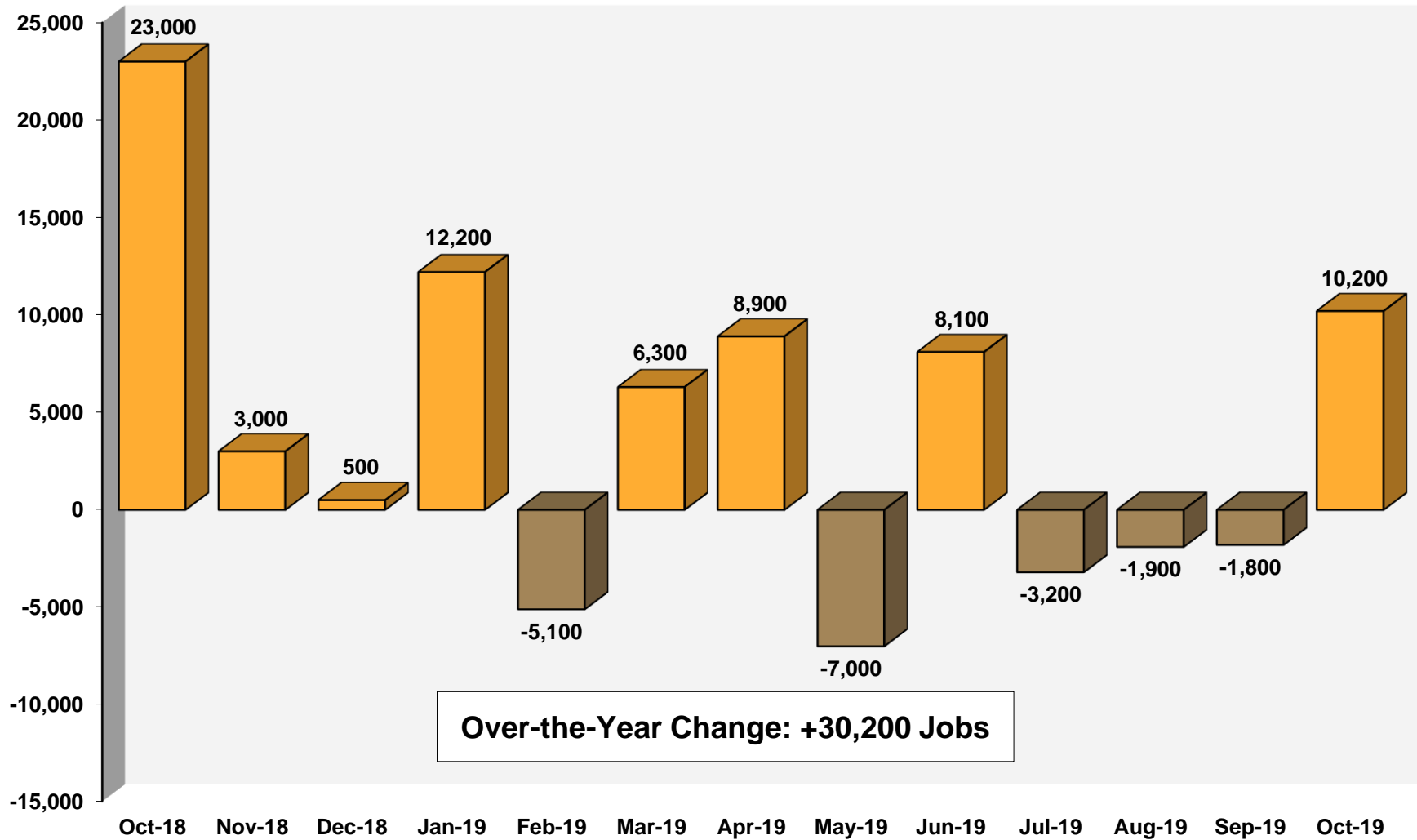
New Jersey Total Nonfarm Employment vs. Monthly Change January 2008 - October 2019



New Jersey Private Sector Employment vs. Monthly Change January 2008 - October 2019



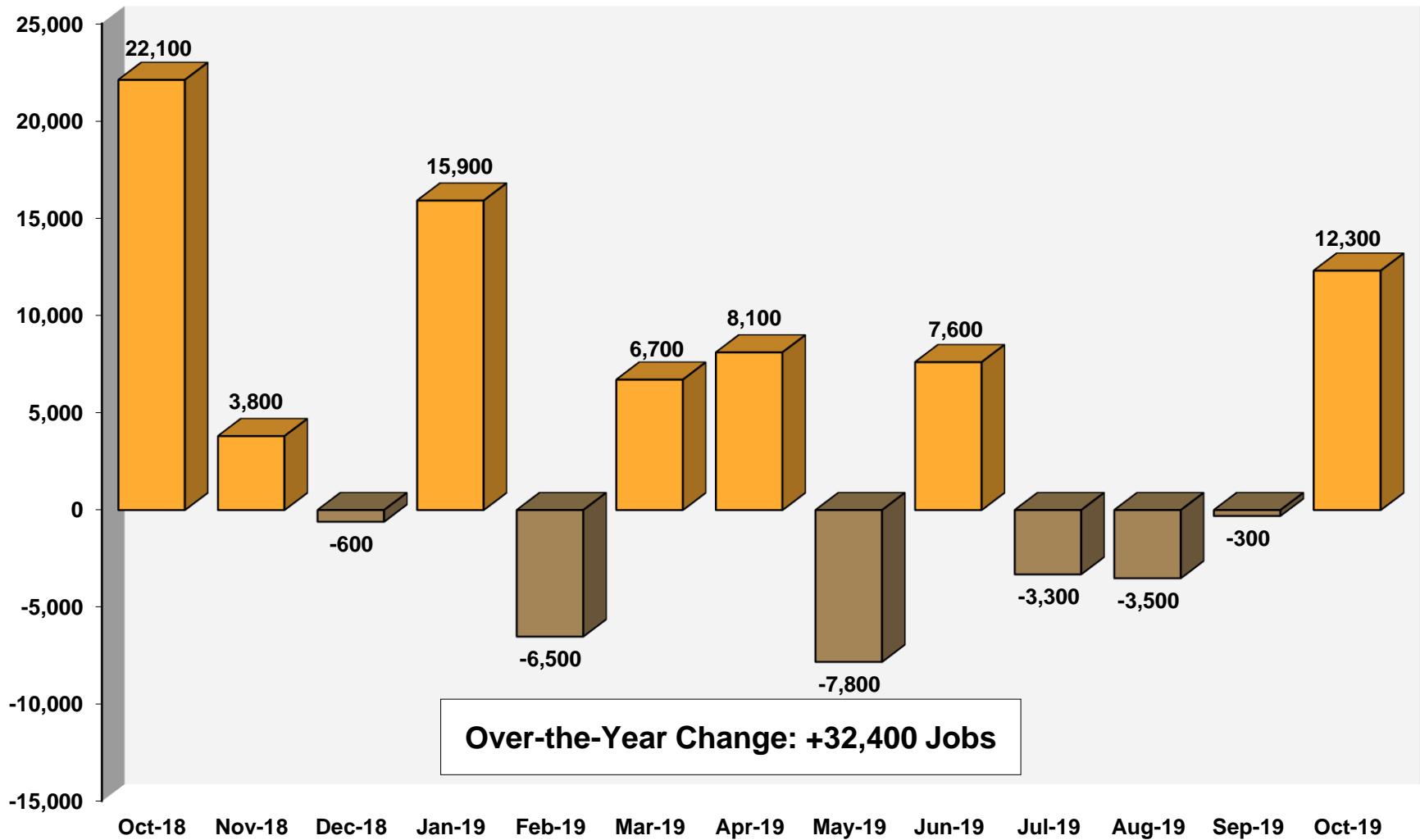
Monthly Total Nonfarm Employment Change New Jersey: October 2018 - October 2019

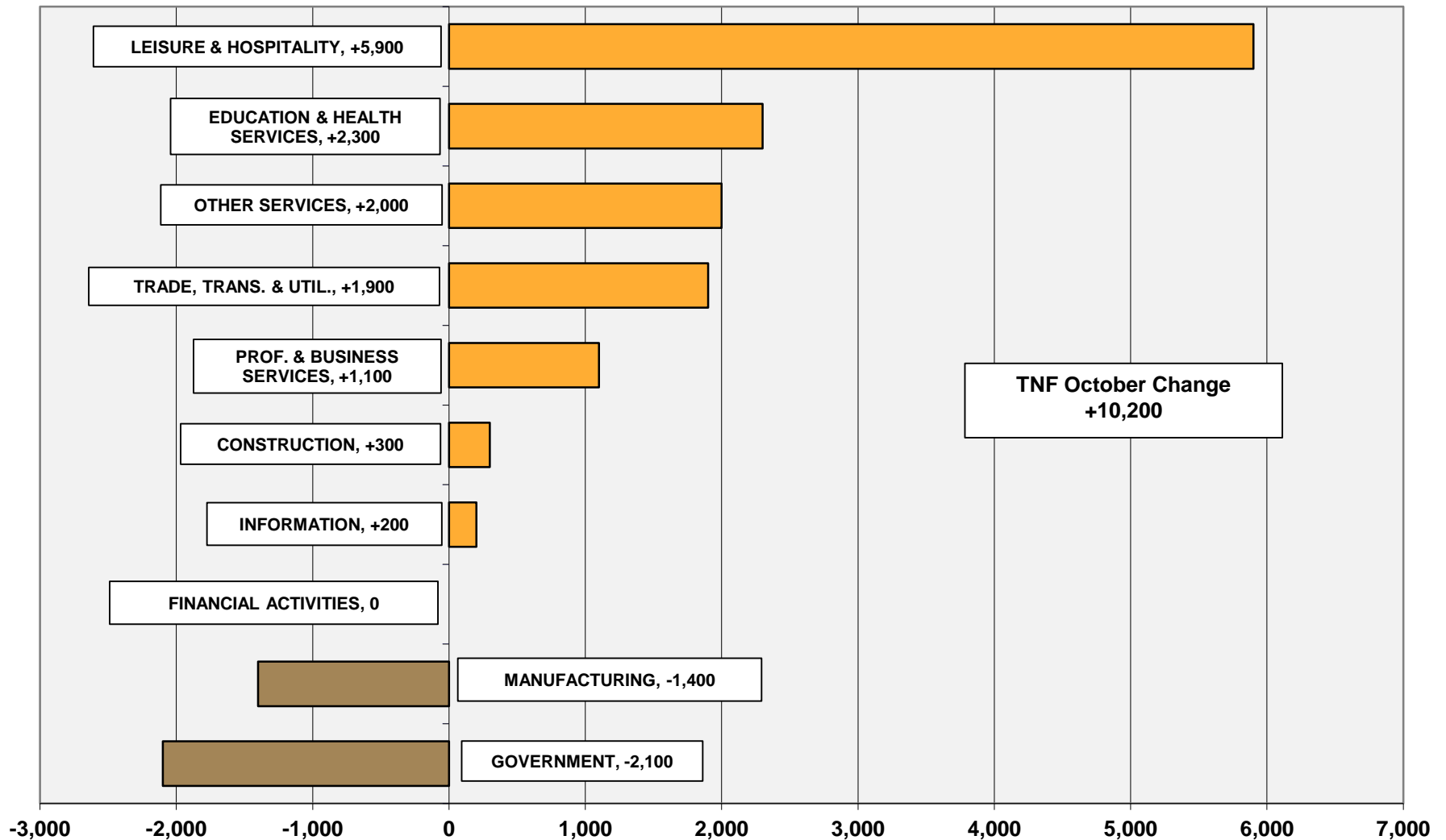
Monthly Private Sector Employment Change October 2018 - October 2019

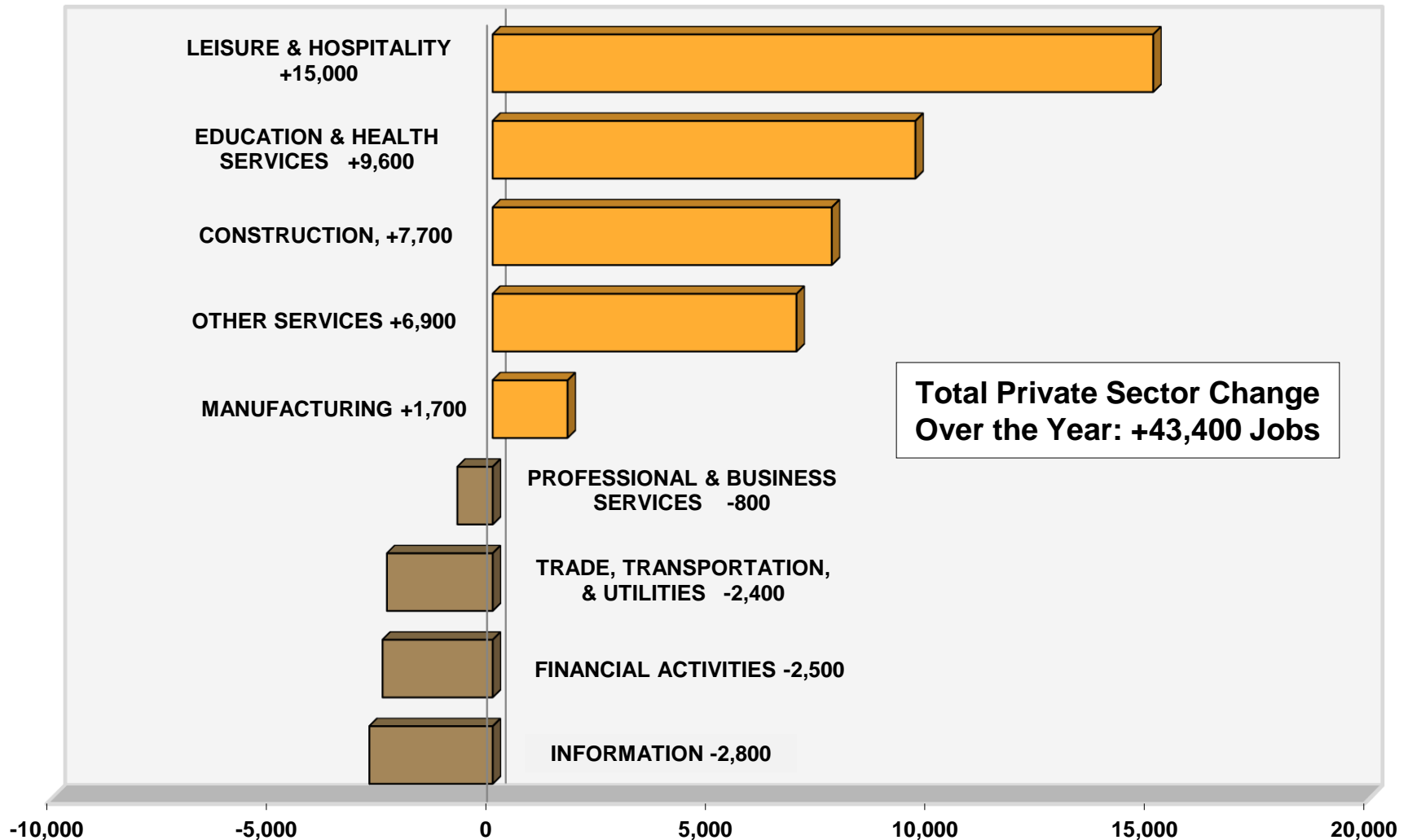
Monthly Employment Change: October 2019

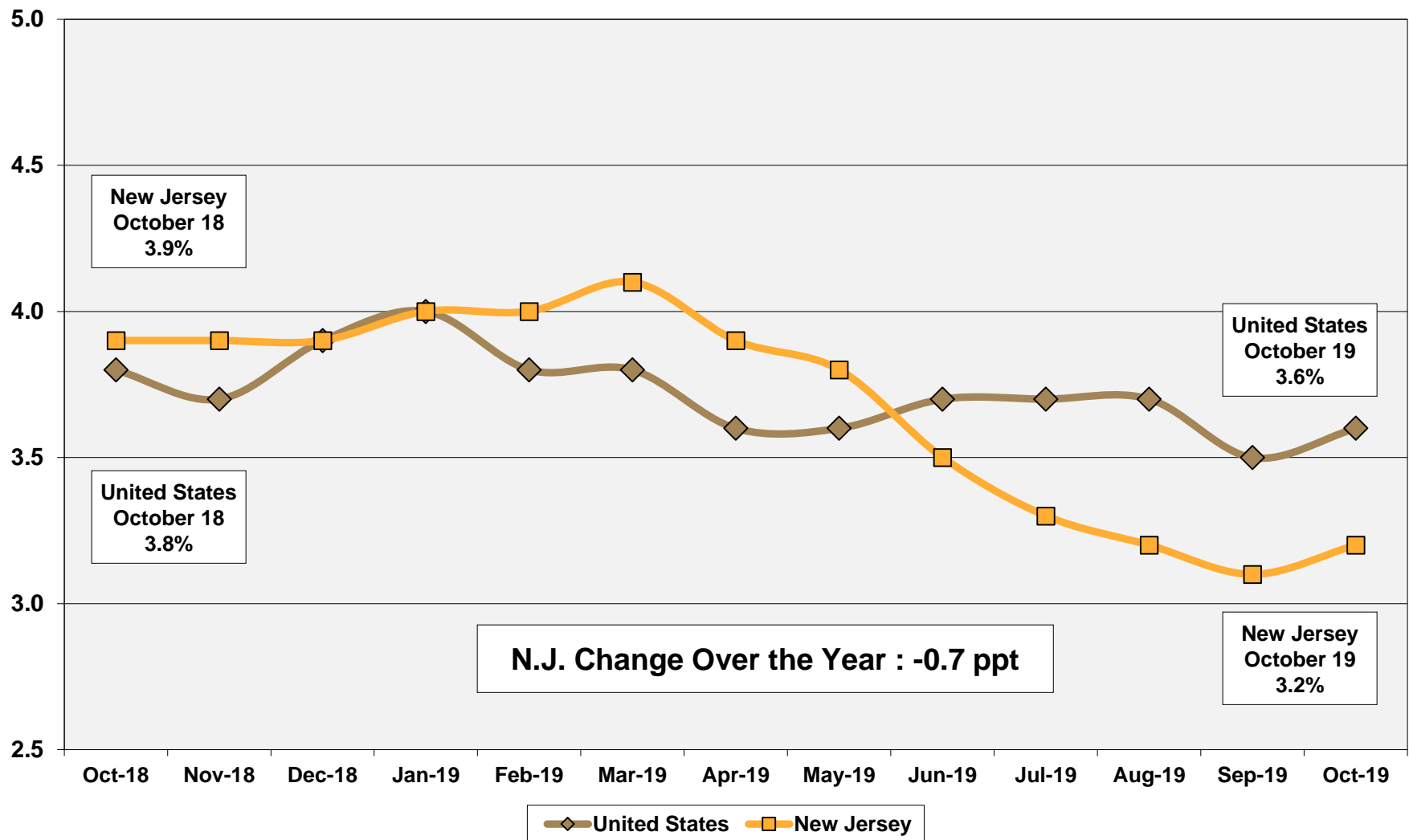
New Jersey Private Sector Employment Change by Industry October 2018 - October 2019

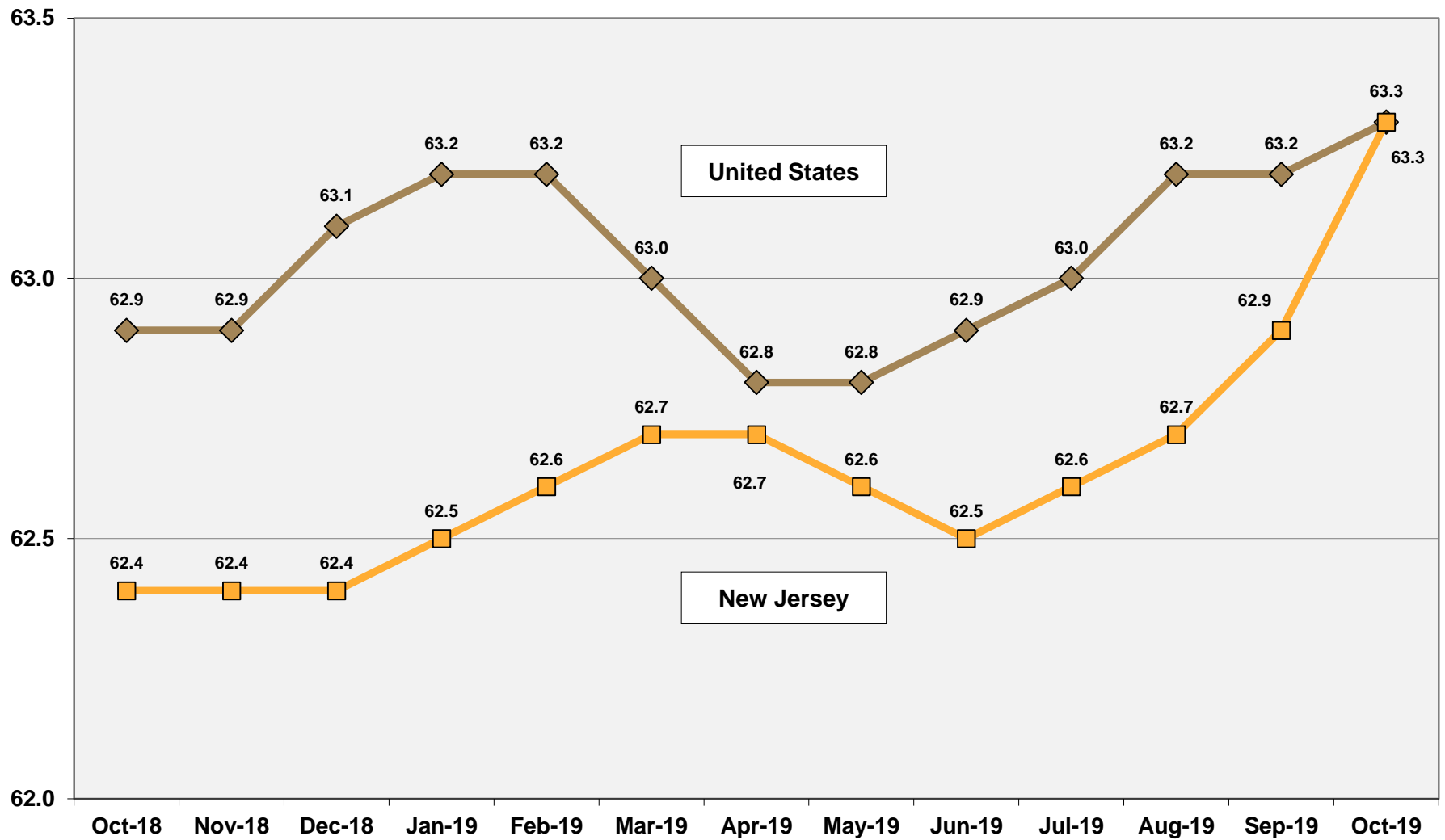
Unemployment Rates, New Jersey vs. United States October 2018 - October 2019

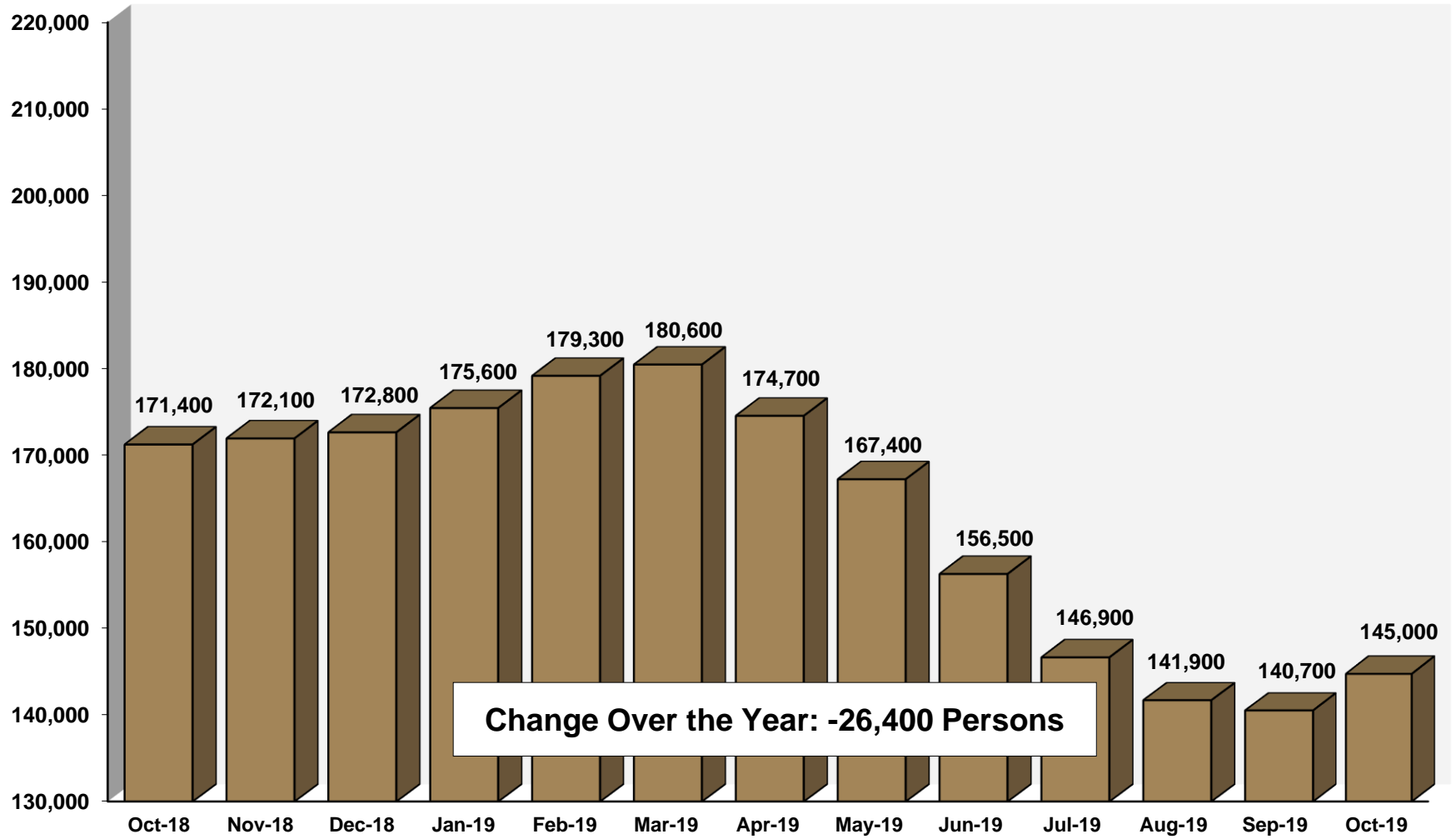
New Jersey vs. United States, Labor Force Participation Rate: October 2018 - October 2019

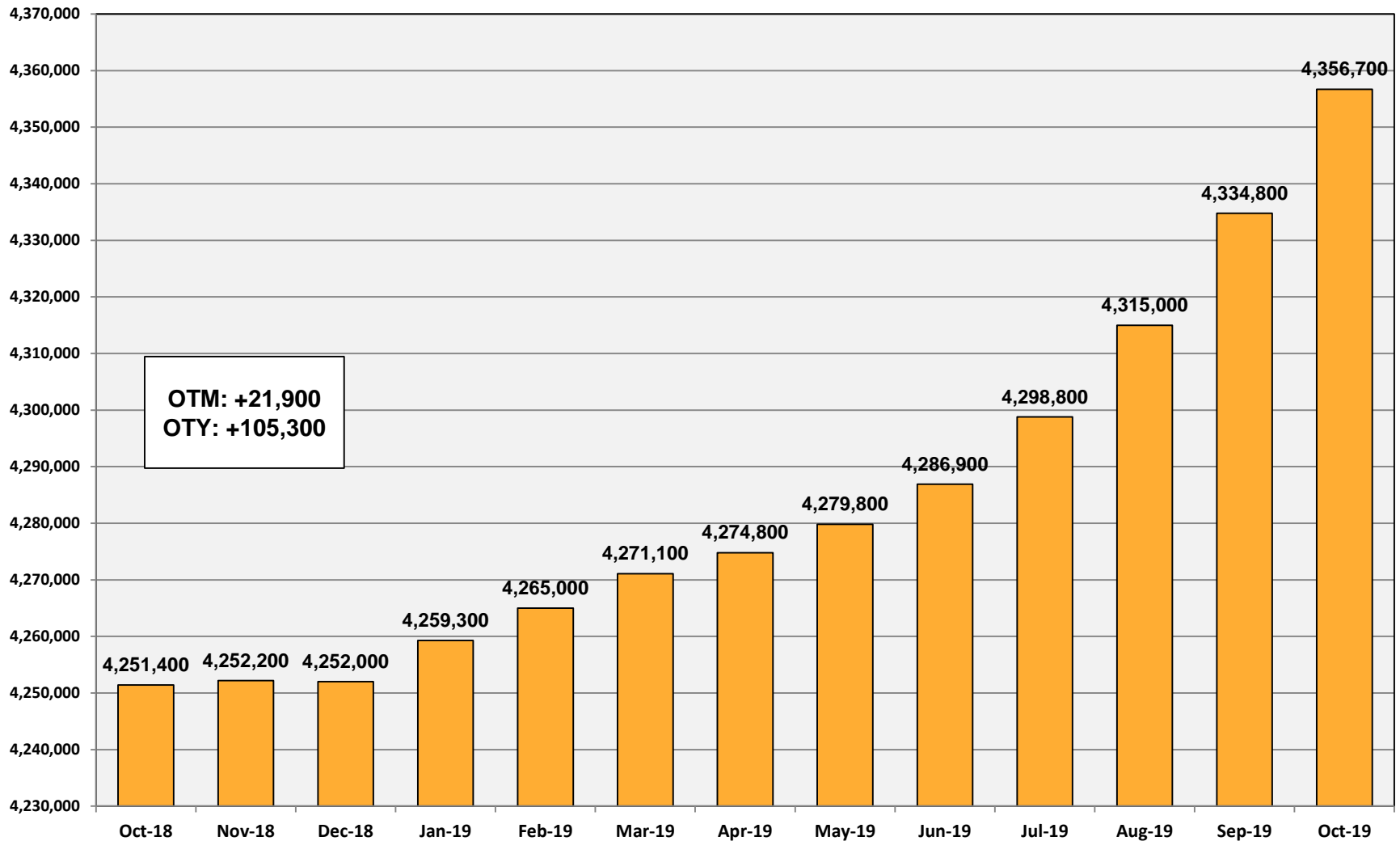
Unemployed New Jersey Residents October 2018 - October 2019

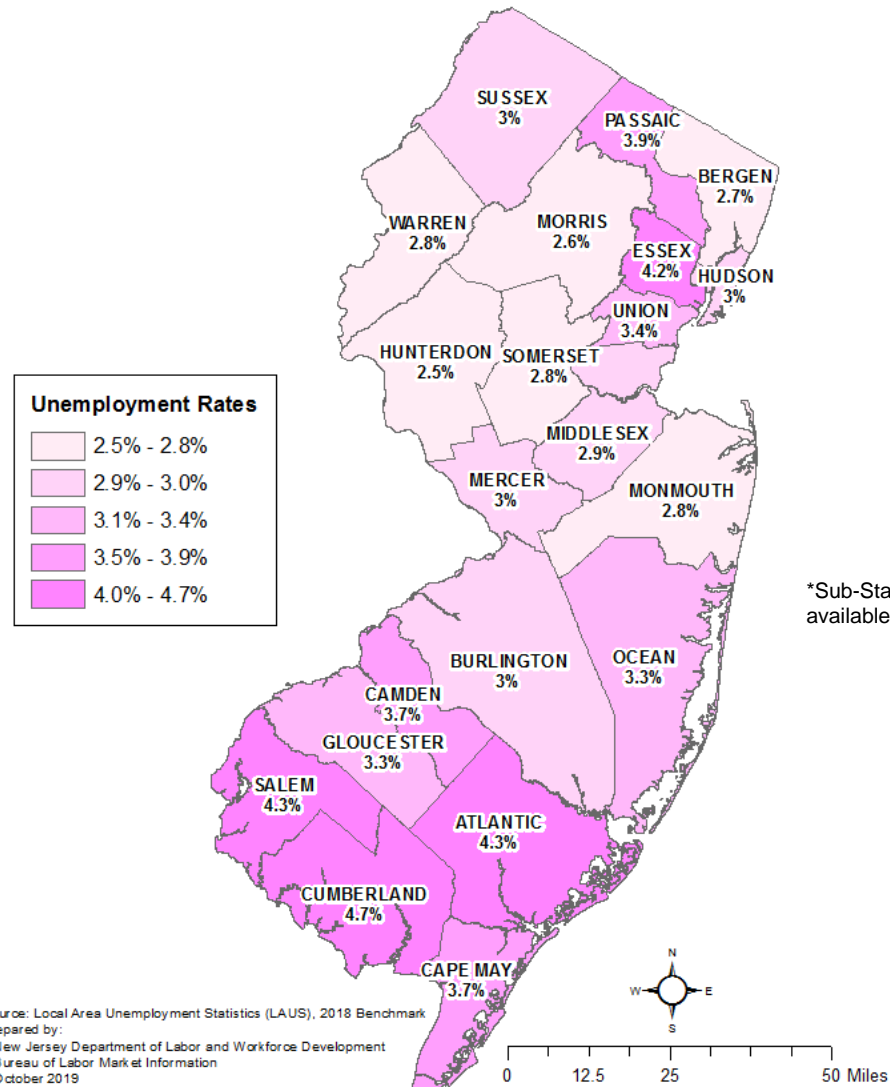
New Jersey Employed Residents: October 2018 - October 2019

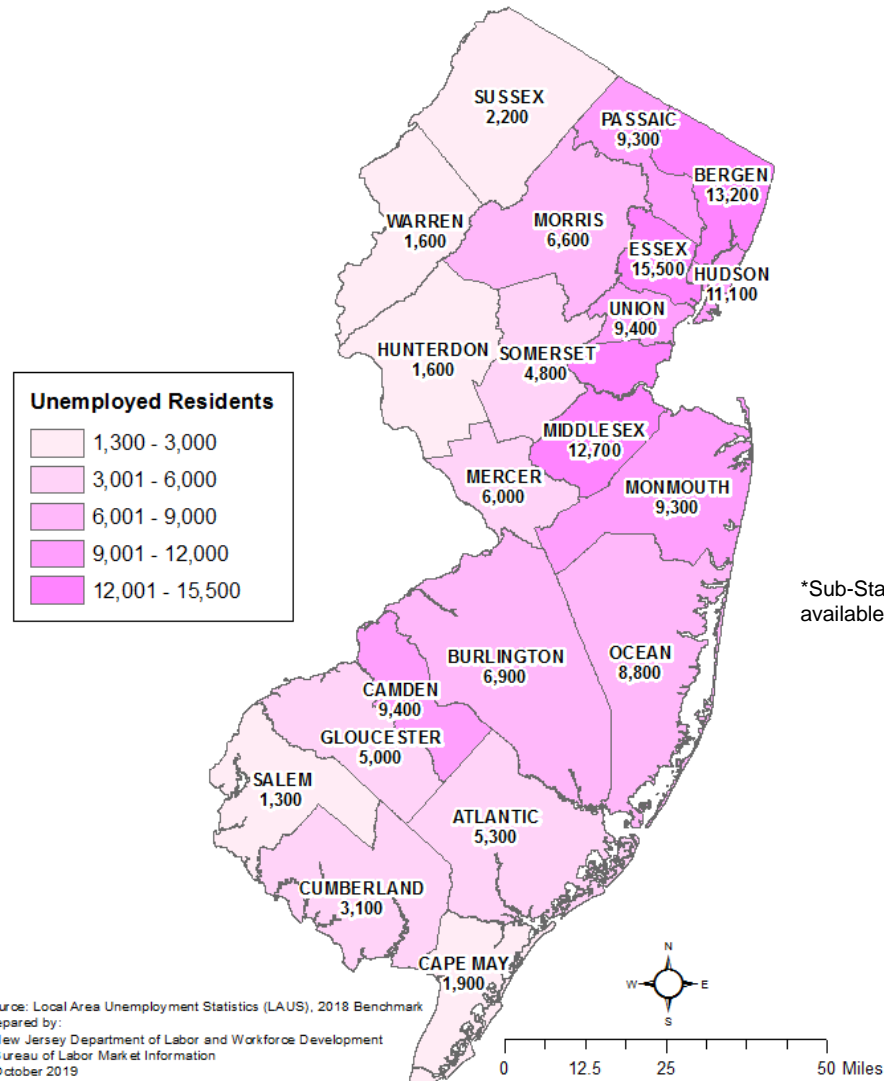
New Jersey Counties Unemployment Rates - September 2019 (Preliminary, Not Seasonally Adjusted)

New Jersey Counties Unemployed Residents - September 2019 (Preliminary, Not Seasonally Adjusted)



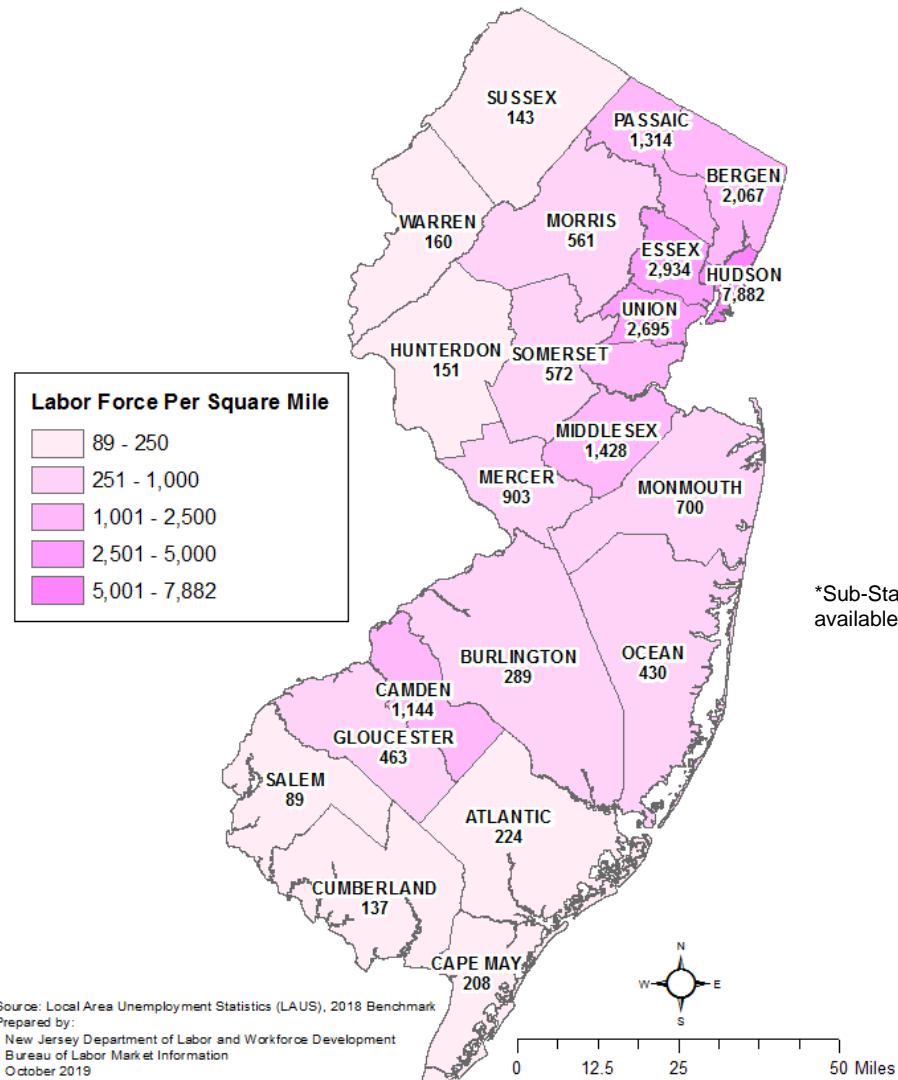

Labor Force Per Square Mile - September 2019

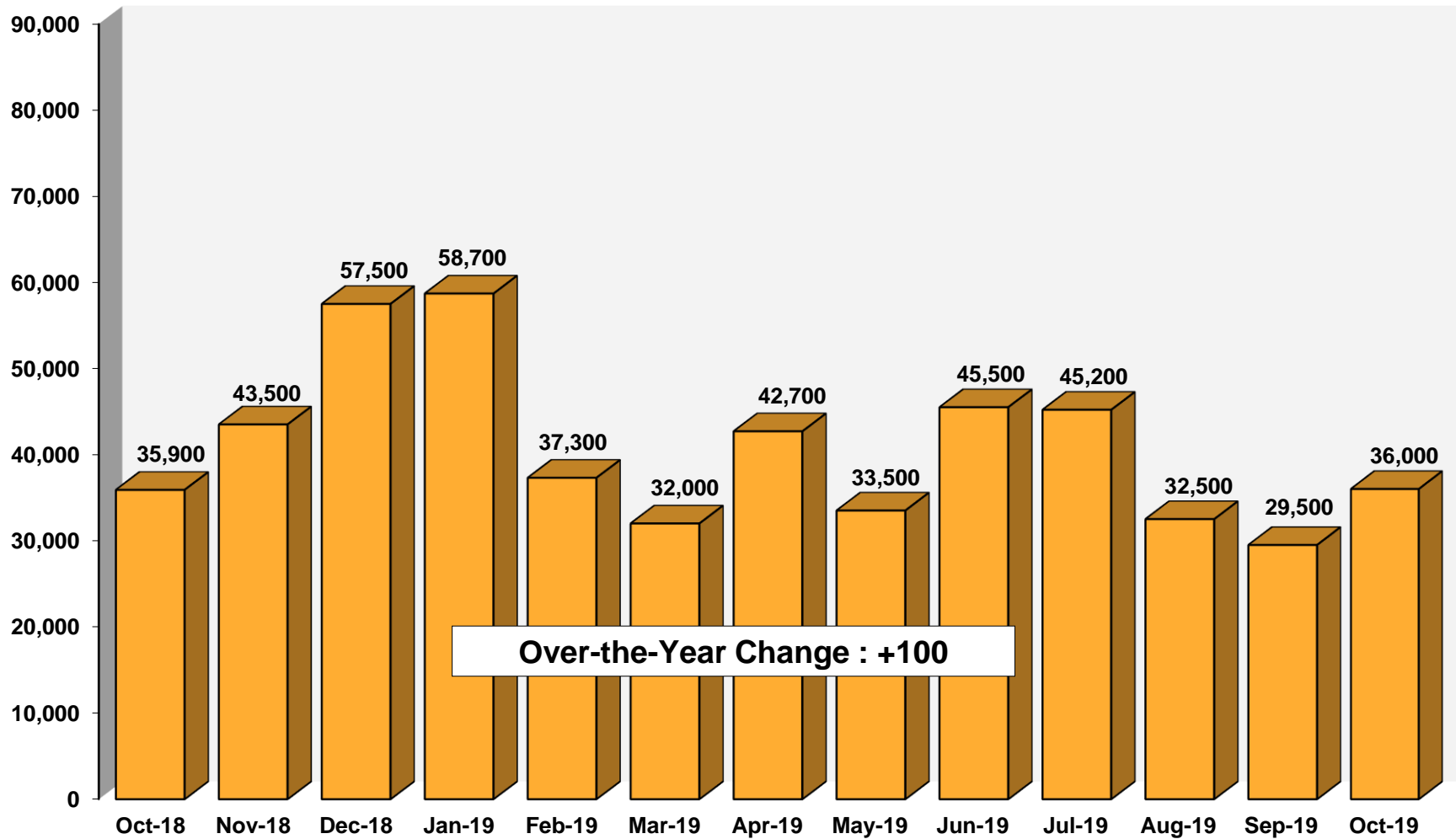
